BACK TO SCHOOL SOON

School leads to many things, as long as you succeed. Every child has the right to a quality education. Our two primary schools in Mamer and Capellen provide invaluable framework for achieving this objective. I would like to thank the teaching staff, as well as those in charge of the Maison Relais, for their unfailing commitment and dedication.

Our municipality is growing at a steady but moderate pace. By the end of the year, we will have exceeded the 11,000 mark in population. More than 800 pupils will be attending the Mamer and Capellen sites at the start of the new school year. The school and extra-curricular infrastructure has to assimilate this challenge. A new Maison Relais transition centre will be available in Mamer, with construction completed towards the end of the year. The new swimming pool is due to open in September 2024. But as important as infrastructure is, it is also necessary to focus on integration, living together and participation in school life. A student delegation structure will be set up with the help of teachers and Maison Relais managers. Parents will be more involved in the school community, for example via modern information channels such as YouTube.

The range of extracurricular courses will be expanded in the areas of culture, linguistics and sports. Extra support courses will be offered outside school hours. Deserving pupils will be rewarded with financial support. Media and digital literacy will be strengthened by extending the iPad for All project.

Schoulbuet has a new look. I wish you pleasant reading. I look forward to seeing you on 15 September and wish you all the very best during your holiday period.

iPad

Pads are increasingly being used as teaching aids. Their use is based on the ICAP model and its four modes of engagement: passive use by watching instructional

videos, active use for research, vocabulary learning, constructive use for recording oral and reading productions and interactive use as part of interdisciplinary promotion of coding. We would like to take this opportunity to thank the municipality of Mamer, who have provided us with a modern and innovative teaching tool.



Physical Activity and Healthy Lifestyle in European Primary Schools (PAHLEPS)



This is a major European project involving Portugal, Ireland, Luxembourg and Spain. The Mamer and Capellen Primary Schools were chosen to represent Luxembourg. The aim of this major project is to map the current situation with regard to best practice in physical activity

THE LUXEMBOURG SCHOOL SYSTEM

I n the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, basic education is provided by state, private or international schools. The state primary school accepts children aged 3 to 12. All children living in Luxembourg who have reached the age of 4 by 1 September must attend primary school.

Early years

Cycle 1 includes an optional first year: early childhood education (3 to 4 years). This enables children to make playful contact with other children. All children who have reached the age of three by 1 September 2023 are eligible for admission. Enrolment is free and children must attend for a minimum of three half-days a week (including at least one afternoon).

The municipality of Mamer will organise a second wave of early education pupils after the Christmas break for children who will have reached the age of three between 01.09.2023 and 31.12.2023.

Enrolment of these children is subject to the availability of places. In accordance with ministerial regulations, school transport is not provided by the municipality for early education.


Cycle 1.1 & 1.2

After early education comes pre-school education, which is compulsory for all children who have reached the age of 4 by 1 September 2023.

This 2-year cycle aims to teach the Luxembourgish language, communication and social skills, as well as introducing children to mathematics and developing their writing skills.

Cycles 2, 3 and 4

(6 to 12 years). These correspond to primary education. For six years, the emphasis is on literacy, learning the German, French and Luxembourgish languages, mathematics, learning about the sciences, particularly the humanities and natural sciences, physical expression, psychomotor skills, sport and health, and learning about aesthetics and culture, including the arts and music. Primary school adapts methods and content to the needs of each pupil, and develops a skills-based approach.



Fundamental education in Luxembourg is organised into fifteen regional directorates. Region 2 includes the municipalities of Bertrange, Mamer, Strassen, Kopstal, Kehlen, Koerich and Steinfort.

Today, as in the past, we learn to read, write and count at school. But learning these skills is no longer an end in itself, but a means to an end, a foundation for further learning. This is why we have defined the necessary skills that every child must acquire at the end of the various stages of their school career. These **core skills are determined by the Luxembourg curriculum,** and enable pupils to move on to the next level and obtain a qualification that matches

their abilities and interests.

Parents are essential partners of the school, and are directly informed of their child's assessment and progress in relation to the objectives to be achieved: at the end of each term, parents are invited to a personal interview.





ASSISTANCE AND SOCIAL SERVICES

Welcome classes for new arrivals

Children who have just arrived in Luxembourg, and who have mastered none or only one of the three languages of primary education, receive support from the people in charge of dispensing reception courses.

These children are enrolled in an ordinary class and receive language lessons as part of the reception courses during normal school hours.

Specially trained teachers accompany the children for a period ranging from a few months to several years. Their language courses are based on an interactive approach.

The aim is to enable children to find their bearings in their new environment, to communicate in the new language and to learn it well enough to be able to follow normal lessons in their ordinary class. During the transition phase, the host teachers provide occasional support to help the children integrate fully into their class.



Municipal subsidy

S ince August 2016, the commune of Mamer has provided a subsidy covering 50% of the costs (up to a maximum of €150 per child/school year) associated with the Home Care Service for sick children. For more information and to obtain the required form, go to www.mamer.lu. Sick children must stay at home and cannot be sent to school or to the Maison Relais.

SCHOOL LIBRARIES

The "Kinneksbond" school campus in Mamer and the Capellen school campus each have a school library. Students from both schools can borrow books from either library. There are over 11,000 books, including 600 audio books. All books are catalogued in a computerized system. The range includes book collections and themed books for children in Cycles 2 to 4, as well as books for Cycle 1 children aged 3 to 6. In addition to illustrated books in German, there are also books in French, Portuguese and English, so that parents can read stories to their children in their mother tongue. Students, parents and teachers can browse the library catalogue at www.mamerschoulen.lu. As parents play a key role in helping their children to learn to read, the Mamer library is also open outside school hours to pupils from the Mamer and Capellen schools.
